FC150.23/24 Parish Biodiversity Survey

Meet with you on site and have a c. 3-hr look around the Parish with you vis-a-vis biodiversity and nature conservation assets.

Following the visit, we'd summarise our findings in an e-mail. Including all associated travel and expenses for this, our fee would be £395-00.

This would include: (i) travel to and from site, (ii) 3 hrs on site touring the parish to make an initial rapid appraisal of current biodiversity hotspots and nature conservation assets within the parish, and to consider potential actions and areas for future biodiversity enhancement, (iii) following the visit, provide an e-mail summary of the findings of the initial assessment, with bullet points detailing key areas of biodiversity importance and wildlife habitat, as well as summary opportunities for enhancement of these, (iv) within the same e-mail, provide a summary list of other areas visited during the tour of the parish, where opportunities for potential habitat creation or restoration to improve biodiversity also exist.
